We don't ask you for personal information. We don't share your personal information with anyone except the Lovewell Pond Association Board. We don't any store personal information on our servers.

## The Lovewell Pond Association

The Lovewell Pond Association, or Property Owners of Lovewell Pond, is a non-profit organization dedicated to the care, enhancement, and preservation of Lovewell Pond, located in Fryeburg, Maine. The LPA is interested in all aspects of lake preservation including: Lake Uses, Wildlife, Water Quality, Public Access, Shoreline, Maine Regulations & Other Associations.

If you have questions about deleting or correcting your personal data, please contact us. The only data we would collect is if you send us an email, we will keep your email address.

## Website Visitors

The LPA website does not collect any data from its users. Our website is publicly accessible, and does not have a security certificate.

## Privacy Policy Changes

LPA may change its Privacy Policy from time to time, and at LPA's sole discretion. LPA encourages visitors to frequently check this page for any changes to its Privacy Policy. Your continued use of this site after any change in this Privacy Policy will constitute your acceptance of such change.

## Protection of Information

LPA discloses information only to those of its board that

(i) need to know that information in order to process it on LPA's behalf or to provide services available at LPA's websites, and

(ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others.

LPA will not rent or sell potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information to anyone.

Other than to its board, LPA discloses potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information only in response to a subpoena, court order or other governmental request, or when LPA believes in good faith that disclosure is reasonably necessary to protect the property or rights of LPA, third parties or the public at large.

If you have shared your email address with LPA, LPA may occasionally send you an email to tell you about lake news, solicit your feedback, or just keep you up to date with what's going on with LPA and our services. We primarily use our website to communicate this type of information, so we expect to keep this type of email to a minimum.

If you send us a request via email, we reserve the right to use it to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. LPA takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information, such as email address.

## Email Communication

LPA sends a newsletter and updates that we believe will be useful to individuals that subscribe to our organization, or contact us through our website. Users may remove themselves from this mailing list by responding to the email with a request to be removed. We will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to third parties unless we are required by law.

## Cookies

A cookie is a string of information that a website stores on a visitor's computer, and that the visitor's browser provides to the website each time the visitor returns. LPA does not uses cookies.
